Parkview volunteers, community workers, teachers, parents, and 188 third graders from Cedarville Elementary School enjoyed the Parkview North Hospital Kids' Safety Camp on Friday, September 27th. Making this event memorable for students were Parkview North and Parkview Health co-workers, along with members of Northeast Fire & Rescue, New Haven Fire Department, the Allen County Department of Child Services, the Parkview YMCA, student nurses from IPFW, and numerous other volunteers.



At various learning stations, students talked with healthcare professionals and first responders. They practiced CPR, experienced what it was like to get out of a burning building in the New Have Fire Department Fire Safety House, and discovered germs under a black light. In addition, they learned about asthma by crawling through an over-sized replica of human lungs. Students also learned about wearing a backpack properly, making healthy food choices, hand-washing techniques, water safety, and first aid.

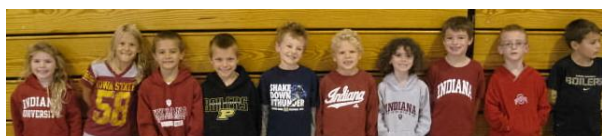

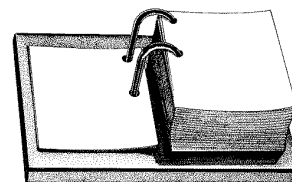
Help Support Leo Jr/Sr High School Band...
